

4. Please list activities you have been involved in and any honors, awards or special recognitions you have received. (These can be academic, athletic, civic, work related, volunteer, hobby, etc.)
5. Please describe one strength *and* one weakness you have.
6. Who is a role model or someone you admire? Why?
7. What advice would you give to the freshmen class?
